Very hard frost last night cold in A.M. got sunny and warmer in P.M. Has been terrible winter spell of weather mangols badly frozen. I plowed for pit and topped mangols in A.M. and Willie brought up load manure from Dennis spread it on No 1 then came over put in load of frozen mangols cabbages etc. In P.M. J. Fernal and W. Graham here we finished mangols to barn put loads in pit hauled them in manure spreader and brought load over at night.

Saturday

Frost last night again fine sunny day snow nearly all gone. J. Fernal and W. Graham up all day we finished mangols to-day 4 loads home and the rest in another pit S.E. of barn we got pits covered. Willie went down town at night paid the boys Jim \$4.00 25cts too much W 75cts paid J. M. Ka \$2.00 for grader, oil for sick sheep 10cts gem 7 lamp burner 15. Bellot down home to-night.
