- Tue June 25. Fine and turned much cooler in eve. ^{2 tons Cool 14:50 per ton} called at Mrs Nobles.
- Wed June 26 Fine and quite cool. I went to Toronto to look for a dress ordered one at the Leah Shoppe. called to ask for Miss Edey who is sick called ^{Called at Mrs Smellies.} at F Beres in eve.
- Thurs June 27. Fine after a light shower in the night. Mabel Welsh called in the afternoon, grass quite burnt.
- Fri June 28. A nice shower in the night helped a little berries ²⁵ but still more needed. School closed.
