When I first got up my head felt pretty
good but later I had some pains
in it so Mother put me to bed.
Mr. and Mrs. O'Neil, Mrs. and Mrs.
Wells were here for dinner. Great
feast including ice cream made
by Prof. C. Bush Jr.

January Wednesday 13 1926

My head ached all day so
I didn't enjoy myself very
much.

Thursday 14

Mother put a mustard plaster
on back of my neck and
my head began to feel
better.

Friday 15

Quite a bright frosty day.
Got up out of bed for the first
time. Roscoe brought Mr. Sidney
up from work to spend evening
with us. Ernie Cochran came in
at night and he & deflated Carl
and Roscoe playing "500".
