20. Dingwall's wife is poorly. had twins they were buried today. Pa got 50 cts of sugar
21. I came up stairs for the sleep
22. I am not very well
23. Boys drawing wood, weather stormy
24. Jimmie left to assess, will not be home until Thursday evening. Got 700 flour at Wilkes 2.40. yeast -
