

James Cameron Island 13th Nov 1900

Froze hard last night Fine East wind
Turned Windy Began to snow about 2
past 4 o'clock. So Lemay here Got 4 lb
of Butter 90 cents Stanley taking over the
Barn Slabs and taken the Flat step
Stones from this House putting Boards
around this house for the Banking
and they took them away to spite me a
Stormy night for a while 14th Fine Cool
West Wind Working over at the Building got
Rat and a Leg Fernandez crossed took 2
Loons Boxed up to send to Montreal to
be stuffed Stanley fixing a place for the
2 Rams as the calves has their place Lots
of Boats went to Day the Ground covered
with snow not much shooting to Day
Froze Last or to night 15th Fine Cool got 2
Scottish Americans from Dan fixing
around the House put the Milk in the
Pantry out of the cellar West Wind
16th Fine Cool W Wind Plastering stables
Freezing to Day and to night putting some
Straw out of the Barn Salmon River
Froze 17th Fine Day E Wind Stanley Plastering
Cow Stable Randolph here Eddy here shot
10 Ducks out on the Blind no Boat out
of Salmon River to Day Seen a Crane
Wind changed to West this Evening
18th Sunday Leander came down from Jos hunting
with Mr. Nally hunting not very good 19th
Began taken the things over to the New
House Raining Snowing Blowing a
blustery ugly time to move got there
after Dark which is not a good omen

James Cameron Island 20th Nov 1900

Rained to night Randolph here shot 5
Ducks Kind of Bad Weather water high
21st On This Day of the Month D Mac-
Master Departed 1846 (mor) Fine Turned
Windy and Rained some Lots of Shooting
to Day Went to the Bay got 2 Rat to Day
First Basking in the new house Randolph
here very windy Stanley working at the cellar
Drain an eclipse on the Sun very very windy
this afternoon and to night and Rain Randolph
stopt to night 22nd Fine Lots of Boats going
to Day 2 Big Steamers passed Down The
D Meigs and Scows Left out here to Day
Ed Renshaw here he is out with So Sally
Took a Lot of Traces of Corn over to the other
House New Moon comes in this Morning
St. Celas Day 23rd Fine Big Wind East night
Went around the Island found a Bunor
Plant Took over The Linn to the other House
Measured 10 Bushels of Wheat to go to Mill
a Rout about the Patchel they took
it out of her Room and hid it on their
Mother Water high took a Jar of Randolph
to Dundee for Oil had Randolphs Boat
some Trees and Limbs Down with the Wind
24th Fine cool East Wind Stanley to Mill to
Day some cool and Windy to night Fixing
irons and Tools in the old House chopping
some a Lot of shooting Below to Day a pair of
overals Bought 25th St. Catharines Day Stormy E Wind
Raining Eddy here 26th Raining Hailing Blowing
East Wind Took over the Milk Snowing 27th Fine
East Wind Randolph here on the Little Island Eddy
here taking over the sticks of the Barn for a pig Pen
2 Boats went up Steam Barge went Down
