Kousclean then I took 12 empty bags to mill for white dust then deposited Miss. money. I got at Merrison aft nails 25 but 15 ds paid J. C 5 \$1.30 for stuff got at Bennets sale got meat at Shortcuts 50 ds brought collars up from Wordens brought roll of fence up for Mr Brown. PM Willie went down in wagon got the white dust at mill 12 bags gave cheque on R B \$16.20 got bread at Simpsons 12 ds he brought Mary up with him. Willie went down to entertainment 62 in T.H at night given by soldiers. Harry Armstrong in morning collecting for present for the Whittan boys who have enlisted we gave \$100.
