- 26 Fine day. A good morning out to church. Duncan McNaughton (Pensioner) was buried this afternoon from a McLaurin home in the 4th. There was a slight shower about 4.30 P.M.
- 27 Fine all day. worked in garden. put out a row of strawberries on each side of carrots
- 28 Muddy went north. to be gone all week. Looks like settled weather. 1 load of hay. ^{day} 48
- 29. Rained in the night. dull and mist. Got factory report. 3 lbs butter. Birdie was down. To 5 loaves 25^{cts}. 1 gall lard oil 23. Got 2 hve handles 10^{cts} each. 1 bit
- 30 Dull day with showers
- 31 Fine day. To 3 lemons 8^{cts} etc. 1 lb raisins 13. I was at D. Campbell's at a quilting. A tenant came to live in our game grower house yesterday 22

August 1903

- 1 Saturday. Fine day. Rev. Peter Watson died suddenly today at Dixons. will be buried on Tuesday ^{Sept 20} to pan bread 20. Rev Kenneth. came home 30
- 2 Fine day. a large congregation 20
- 3 Fine day. Thomas 2 loads hay.
- 4 Dull in morning. began to rain at noon. To 4 lbs steak 40. 1 pan bread 20. 1 lb tea 30 90
2 packets mince for pie 20. Allan & Flora McDunnan came for the funeral. There were eight ministers present. all officiated. Marion came in evening. 20
- 5 Rain
- 6 Fine in morning. Stormed about 6 P.M. W. T. M. I. at John Ross but river I was not there
- 7. Fine all day I was at Willis. lot chuse 35 35
4 yds bed tickin for a petticoat for Marwa 30
- 8 Fine in forenoon. Thomas put in 3 loads of hay here. Major 2 yesterday. John Montroy \$100 for rent. To 1 pulocou 20
4 lb steak 40^{cts}. 3 lbs butter factory
- 9 Sunday. Rain today. fl. to dinner myself &
- 10 Muddy took Marion to see Birdie & left her there. To mutton 30^{cts}.
- 11 Rain all forenoon Mrs Montroy all day 50
four loaves 20 Major load of hay
John Burgess' house was burnt today. At noon the fire broke out. at 4 P.M. it was all gone. they saved most every thing on the lower story
- 12 Fine but looks like rain Jimmie went to Branch will remain a few days if the weather keeps dry. Pa got his account from M Crimmon. And 5⁰⁰ dollars on the rent. Got credit for Annie Johns 3⁰⁰, on his account that will reduce her acc. 23⁰⁰.
