Heavy rain last night, sunny and cloudy to-day. Willie and I drove down to Gus Switts with Jess in buggy looking for a horse to buy then to Geo Armstrongs to Mr. Gladders to Duffield to Andersons to Pattersons to Rutterfords then home by six o'clock started at nine in A.M. did not get a horse, were offered some at following prices \$300 \$270 \$250 \$225 \$170 \$140 \$95. On road home got at Mennis on afe 1 lb paris green 25 cts 6 lbs blue stone at 8 cts 48. Miss Aggie Mitchell of R.A.H. up for tea Miss Hilpatrick up in evening. Saw Frank Dodge at Scotts.

Wednesday

Fine sunny day. Willie went down town with Jess in buggy got at Lous line 5 cts at Mills meat 25 at Armstrongs on afe shorts \$1.20 pine apples 35 cts. Willie cut some hay in 1107 in A.M. I got stuff ready and in P.M. we put paris green and Bordeaux mixture on potatoes. after tea Willie finished cutting hay he started in A.M. Mr. Goss over in evening got some celery tomato and cabbage plants.
