Management of Surgical Cases—No. 3.

The removal of sutures or uterine stems must be looked after carefully.

Binders are frequently necessary in post-operative abdominal cases, the period of use depending on the nature of the case.

The laced front corset which is made to fit and be supported by the back and hips is invaluable in all women with weak pelvic outlets or a tendency to uterine displacement. Properly used it lifts rather than depresses the abdomen.—Leigh; *Int. Journ. of Surg.*
