

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 20, 1870.

To day It has not been fit to work out on account of rain. The boys fixed up fence Mrs Gornbow this afternoon worked around the barn.

I have been working in the shop most of the day.

There has been in my mind the past day a good deal of uneasiness and doubt because some things do not come so fast as I would wish. But this I know is not right. I ought so to trust in the word that my work might be like Mount Sion which cannot be moved. Lord help me to do all that thou requirest!

THURSDAY, APRIL 21, 1870.

The boys have been going up fence to day. It is so wet that we can do nothing else. I have been working at a new wagon-rack and am getting it nearly done.

This morning, on rising, my first desires were for a great plume in the fountain of knowledge for sin and uncleanness. I felt a lack of strength but on making the effort found that my strength was renewed, as the result of my interview was, another victory over the enemies of my work. Had also at about another precious treasure when I was over more than ever filled with the
