- 17 To finish our work I went to manage with Jim Webster the Counties was up looking at the thousand hands to see if they can purchase them from the poor cut a ditch at the road to let the water of the road & took the gate post out & sunk it deeper & being the gate better
- 18 To J. Ellen went to younge this morning I fixed up our old single harness & oiled them
- 19 Ad came home to day all well at younge I mended Ellens boots & fixed them up
- 20 Rev. W. Robinson preached in the morning & Mr. Ferguson at night
- 21 we went to Kellenbeck & worked in the roads for Ad place
- 22 Ad drew stones & sand for Sykes. I worked at the old harness so as to fix them up for Mr. Ferguson
- 23 Ad specked the roof of the old barn I mixed plaster for to patch plastering of the house
- 24 Hugh Mc Kay plastered the packing of the barn this forenoon Ad went through the corn & potatoes
- 25 went to Escott with 3 bushel of fall wheat that I got of John Johnston got it ground fine rain this fore noon every thing is very much refreshed
- 26 worked at the corn & potatoes Ellen & Mary come home from younge to see Billie
- 27 Rev. W. Ferguson preached this morning ^{Mr.} Cunningham at ^{night}
- 28 I went to Delta with Billie & Beque to attend an agreement meeting stayed all night. the fall Fair is to be in Delta the 7th & 8th of October next
- 29 come home to day with fine Margaret Billie come home with us
