Fri July 3<sup>rd</sup> fore noon light clouds and hot after noon heavy thunder and Showers. Sarah was here doing up pickles and preserves. this fore noon

Sat July 4<sup>th</sup> fore noon cloudy after noon clear and warm. I was hoeing corn Bilton was here most of the after noon

Sun July 5<sup>th</sup> fore noon cloudy after noon clear

Mon July 6<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. I pick berries in the fore noon after noon I sprinkled potatoes and Sheld corn <sup>the</sup> for chickens

Tue July 7<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. I cut some weeds and grass about the yard
