Tue Aug 14th clear part of the day. we were helping B. & H. Sneyer thrash in the fore noon. and Walter all day. I was turning and pulling peas in the after noon.

Wed Aug 15th cloudy looked like rain a little came this Evening. I was helping J. H. Sneyer, thrash in the fore noon. after noon drawing peas Charly helping with his team. Walter laid up with a sore eye.

Thu Aug 16 clear most of the day and hot. I was hot pulling ~~peas~~ peas. Walter was getting manure out on the ground for fall wheat.

Fri Aug 17 cloudy and misting rain in the morning clear and pleasant the after noon. I finished pulling peas. Walter hauling out manure Sat. Aug 18 clear and pleasant. we were drawing and stacking oats. we drew two loads of peas in the baro.

Sun Aug 19 clear and hot.

Mon Aug 20th clear and pleasant. we finished drawing in our oats. and houses the reaper, mower and horse rake, for this year.

Tue Aug 21 cloudy high wind from the North this Evening and cool. we finished drawing in peas being the last of our grain until we come to the corn.

Wed Aug 22 cloudy fore part of the day and quite cool. Clear latter part I was pulling pursley out of the turnips this fore noon and helping to take them away three Steers I sold to a drveier after noon was helping McDortash thrash. Walter was getting out manure

Thu Aug 23 clear and pleasant. I was hoing turnips. Walter was hauling manure in the fore noon after noon commened to plow for fall wheat.
