we were at home all day. ^{104 here.} Willis family here. we had
straw berries 12 cts a basket.

Mon July 3. Very very hot. 103 degrees. Willie helping in the
afternoon. Mother and Sizzi here all day.
everything burning up.

- Tue July 4. Very warm
- Wed July 5. Very warm a thunder storm but only very little rain. lightning fired Mr Deolins hay field. Willie helped men take down walnut tree.
- Thur July 6. Fine but very, very hot until evening turned cooler. Aunties went Mr Smellies to pick berries in eve. got about $3\frac{1}{2}$ qts. Willie here in afternoon
- Fri July 7. Fine and much cooler. Aunt M and I got about $5\frac{1}{2}$ qts berries. Marjorie here to tea, Aunt Mattie and I at Frank Teasdale in the evening.
- Sat July 8. Fine and warmer. Aunt Nellie picked 2 qts berries. everything drying up for rain.
- Sun July 9. Fine but extremely hot and dusty. Uncle and Aunt Nellie at morning church.
- Mon July 10. Rained a little in afternoon. Mr Deolins man helped in the morning with hay. struck a tree with lightning
- Tue July 11. Aunt Mattie went for berries but got very few. Uncle in Toronto in the afternoon. Aunt Nellie at Mary Watsons in the evening. a little shower with severe thunder and lightning.
- Wed July 12. Very fine and cool. dust all settled. I went to Toronto in the afternoon. men at hay finished all but rakings.

- Tue Dec 19. Fine day and mild, roads very badly cut up.
- Wed Dec 20. A beautiful day frozen clear, roads very rough.
 Sold Turkey hens - 19 lbs 20 cts - 38 0
 Uncle, Aunt Nellie and I at the Presbyterian Xmas Tea.
- Thur Dec 21. A cold east wind a little sleet but not such a bad day. Wilkes' butchering, home by 3 o'clock.
- Fri Dec 22. Mild and foggy, started to rain in afternoon. Uncle Aunt Mattie and I went to decorah. Uncle went to Richmond Hill.
- Sat Dec 23. Fine and mild, fresh buds on Black Currant-bush. Uncle in Toronto.

quite mild then at dark turned cold and windy.
