- 28 Fine day after the few days of cold rain Pa & Jimmie are making a hovel in the cellar wall, kitchen, East end, to shut the air down on the north. Pa's The flour 50 butter 1.23
To 7 lb evl 49. 50 sugar 25. blue 57. Beef 70cts 32
- 29 To 2 lbs butter 50. Another pair 18.00 this week
