We hoed some ~~turnips~~^{mangels}
in morning and worked
around barn rest of the
day. moving straw and
trimming feet of cattle
and colts. went up
to Tom's in evening and
we have partly arranged to
give him five or six cows

5^c and 4^c per lb. if over
900 lbs at 14^c they are 6^c if over
700 they are 5^c if under 700 they
are to be 4^c. And cows when returned to be in as good

condition as he got ^{them} Saturday. 17th fair

Father plowed Turnip ground
Jimmie finished hoeing field
Mangels. and harrowed turnip
and potato grd. Jimmie, Mary
& I pulled all our mustard
on about 35 acres in three hrs
we went to town in evening
bought groceries. 128^c. dry goods
