- Mon Mar 26. Dull and damp quite mild. came a thunder storm early in the evening, lights out. rained part of night then turned stormy and colder. cleaned clothes closets Drawers. Mr Baker called with Syrup. 1.15 per half gallon. I called at Mrs Rich Simpsons in afternoon with syrup.
- Tue Mar 27. Strong winds and light snow. very cold.
- Wed. Mar 28. Fine but cold. n.w. wind. I aired furs, cleaned cellar headway steps ^{at social Mrs Morsimus.}
