

- April 24. Frost. Ice $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Sowing oats in 6 & 4 arroyos in 12. it has been
 a very slow spring sleighing gone on 14 March. being a week later than 1900
- 25 Rain Sat night. Picking straw in 12 and started sowing 3-6 bars at night
- 26 Frosty morning finished sowing 12 and arroyos at started to rise in 2
- 27 Too much frost to sow or sow into morning. facing 7 bar of Big Pen, finished
 sowing in 2 and arroyos. started to sow it. took from the sack of sample
 Put 3 bolls out. A & John to Fergus Mary Samuels. Butter 25⁰⁰ a lb
 (Sunday)
- 28 Frost yet. but got warmer. A. Jim & Leith to Ch. John and Mary in evening
- 29 Rain and thunder in morning. missing brass, such. and Daubeny oak
 and Bealy Bush of back Jim Mike got out. Swallow here
- 30 Thunder & Rain nearly all night and this forenoon turning cold at night
 The land badly flooded an river very high. The coldest April for 59 years
 and one with little rain or snowfall until today. been a cold raw month
- May 1 Hard frost no seeding till noon. on the shade frost all day. sowing (mixed
 grain in 10. Pige (13) Lambs (Triple) (milder at night)
- 2 Slight frost. but warm day. finished sowing 10-102222⁷ & oak in 2 arroyos
- 3 Fine. finished arroyos 10 & 2. all sowed but 4 which is very wet up
 taking sponge & the re. Ploffam. some have got some sowed yet
- 4 2 inches of snow the morning and snowing until 8. gone by noon sunny
 after but. cold. cleaning up oats took up gag bedding & sowing 1st Root
- 5 (Sunday) Fine. A. Jim & Leith up to Lils
- 6 Day & warm to Fergus. Re Pritchard got that dead. Flour 10. &
- 7 Fine cultivating sowing & arroyos in 4 Jerry Beckins came to Lene
 started between 8 & 9
- 8 Fine warm. got all sowed but wet piece at bottom of 4
- 9 Frost all the week (light) started sowing potatoes. started sowing for potato
- 10 Cold. Rain. snow & ice but night cold all day finished sowing for that
 Jerry Fencing on line potatoes. & Pritchard Thompson and us
- 11 Very hard frost. Ice on in thick out thawing in the shade all day. a home
 John to 7. ^{very little but not done} Mary & Rhoda never came up. got 2 lbs soft ware from
 (Sunday) another hard frost & ice milder at night. John & Mary & Char
- 13 Better weather warmer. a high prying wind. finished sowing on creek the foot
 of 4. leaving the black much sowing grass seed on it only 1 lb of old mares
- 14 Warmer. windy. Putting wire across river at 6 o'clock. Jim in forenoon
 To. Mrs. W. B. Thompson & several in afternoon
