Raining last night and more or less all day very heavy at times. We did indoor work to-day fixed troughs in big pen made whiffletires etc etc. We put the six fat cattle that we left over in the stable to-night

19

Thursday

Cloudy day rain at night again. Willie plowed in No 6 Perin plow & horses to-day. I pulled and trimmed some turnips. Willie down on wheel at noon got answer from Reynolds A.C. re letter about draining plan. Lamb died of blood.

20

Friday

Cold cloudy day raining and snowing most of day. Willie plowed in No 6 in AM I trimmed some more turnips. In P.M. we weighed following cattle. Tom White 1280. Little 1150. B. Bowler 1110. B & White heifer 1000. Sir Julian 1070. Blackie 1155. very windy day disagreeable weather.

21

Saturday

Cold cloudy day ground all covered with snow in morning melted by night. snowing some. Willie took 8 bags 932 lbs cow chop to Wilsons in morning and brought it up again 400 lbs dry goods at Woods 25 rods fixed at Dupluis 10 etc. In P.M. I plowed in No 6 along fence pushed red get with snigle plow then we went up to see cattle at Wilsons. Satyr cabed to-day brucey red. Willie down town at night got at Russells goods \$8.93 make see bill. Ruly and Annie Allen left home this week.
