January 29 Wednesday Toward

 wood on circular saw to-day got it in orchard
 Mr Less over in P.M. paid Willie \$2.00 for
 hauling manure ~~Wells~~ ~~just~~ ~~from~~ ~~sack~~ ~~to~~ ~~the~~
 yard to front Willie paid mts. Willie drove
 me down town at night. I went to prayer
 meeting (Mr Mullan conducted it) then J. R.
 Caldwell and I finished auditing J. Serphin's
 books finishing this everything. I got sleppery then
 at Phillips 12 etc paid J. Serphin in full for framing
 and making plumb out of our maple \$4.00
