

- 17 Ad & Sizer came on the morning in June 1850

- 18 Ad finished splitting the wood no. Springs went  
 19 Ad laid up some of the line fence & quilled some  
 20 Ad laid up some of the fence in the forenoon went to the ground  
 of a son of Mr. Hild at the River <sup>about a mile</sup> ~~about a mile~~ <sup>cut of the</sup> ~~cut of the~~  
 21 Ad went to the River to fish with it. At Bradley the fence  
 is done running
- 22 Ad worked at the line fence part of the day  
 there was rain & a snow part of the day  
 23 Ad got the line fence finished he had the wood  
 of it to take apart. I was not able to help him  
 I am so lame with the Rheumatism in my left  
 24 put up the Road fence in the forenoon put  
 a gate at the gravel pit & put a lock on it  
 because the people will leave the Box down  
 & the Sheep & Cattle get in the way
- 25 The Rev. Mr. Robinson preached this morning  
 saw out there is about 6 inches of snow on the  
 ground this morning & it contains the dirt & rain  
 26 Most of the day  
 27 Ad was looking for the Sheep most of the  
 day he got some of them at Mr. Emert's ways  
 & others at Fellers they got at the pit bars  
 28 Ad went with Ellen to Mr. Mitchell he died at 9 o'clock  
 last night he left Ellen there
- 29 Ad went to the funeral of Mr. Mitchell he took  
 the double buggy <sup>with</sup> the Beams the Rev. Mr.  
 Carral officiated the Church was filled I was  
 not able to go I am bad with my eyes & knees
- 30 Ad put up middle fence in between the ditch  
 it was all blown down with the wind  
 31 placing up the front part at night  
 is too wet to place it is driving snow
