Settled up to this Date with I Summers 1 Dollar forsey 11.  
Bought 10yds 2 Dollars 15yds 1inf 2 Bottles .50 1 spool 5  $\frac{1}{2}$   
Dye paper 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  2 pens 2 cents matches 1 5..20 $\frac{1}{2}$   
Settled up till to Day with Mr Ward the hide  
Wood. I want 2 to stand for me which makes  
us clear till to Day I Bought to Day commencing  
a new account. 30 lbs of B Wheat in 37  $\frac{1}{2}$   $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs  
100 30 Soda 10 alum 3 copperas 5 3 lbs Rice 18 pepper  $\frac{1}{2}$  lb  
10 " 2.135 Am Patterson and Massal Hamletton Tom  
Kennedy got a Ride Down from Wm Colcl  
East Wind Ranolo Eph Cane home John  
Andrew Cameron's Chest I depicted yesterday  
and the other not expected to leave 27<sup>th</sup>  
A fine Day running some 28" chopping soft  
at the Barn 1st yellorch St David's Bay  
Stormy came in like a Lion Drift line  
the trees all Bent with Snow keeping the  
Cows at Browsing in the Bush cold  
2nd Ash Wednesday Fine Blowing Drifting  
chopping stone Wood some cold 3<sup>rd</sup> William  
Henry Shadgate Cameron's Birth Day a very fine Day drew some  
Wood Foggy in the morning 4<sup>th</sup> East Wind kindly soft in  
the morning Wind turned high Blew very hard Rained  
Drove and up to Mr Hopkins telling his co. house  
with ice a Post box Linsmith three I bought of him  
7 pieces of Tins 2 Bread Pans 3 Tin Basins Tea Pot Wash Basin 1.35  
Went to Fort Compton with 3 Pairs of Boots Paid Mr Streeter  
1.50 Boots all Paid at Mr Kless for lunch 14 cents - stocking  
Plaster or Court Plasters 8 cents got an almanack at Mr. G. Liss camp for  
2 or 5 Paid I know what I owed him only took 25 cents  $\frac{1}{2}$  lbs Tea 25  
Soda 8 Soap 9 cents Candy 2 Matches 2 Bottles 15 cents 3..58 cents  
got a Ride down from Charles Parsha to Hopkins  
an awful blow of East Wind and drifting stuff  
at Hopkins all night Mr Streeter  
to send the 2 pairs of Boots over to Mrs.  
Wards next week Got 1 pair bended took  
home Free

Mr H H Binnion Island 5<sup>th</sup> March 1881  
Took Breakfast at Mr Hopkins it is a very fine Morning  
Wind still & very East Wind but not cold Bad with  
my Rheumatism to day drew a load of Wood  
Cokes a Browning in the Bush going up on  
the ice on my track that Bushed Randolph  
turned them back 6<sup>th</sup> Snowing fine showing  
Gordon here brought home my short gun some  
Powder caps and shot 7<sup>th</sup> fine crept to Summerour Bay  
of Summers course come 12<sup>th</sup> Brought up Mr Ward  
1 pair of SS record 26 centon credit 14 feet of thread 5  
cents paid in to see Mr Spin he got 2 bags of Potatoes  
from Hamilton got some paper from Mr Baker  
the cleasels Bill on the front and all over  
Snowing ice up the front 1 Bag of Potatoes at  
Hamiltons 1st out the Horse eat the winter past  
I am going up tommoro 8<sup>th</sup> Mr Wills  
Departed Randolph Went for a Baker  
Sleek and Hamlets bought two cents candle  
A fine Day Randolph made to Port Louis to see  
Mr Henry Henric slept in St Amant met  
Mr Henric there went down with him  
had a treat and got a bottle full  
took dinner at Henries lot 3 Bags of  
Oats 1 Bag of Potatoes a Herring Barrel  
some barley and 30 lbs of oatmeal 54 lbs  
Buckets of sugar make up those shoe stakes for  
hanging the Buckets etc  
On the 9<sup>th</sup> Mr Henric's brother came home stopped  
at St Amant I bought crackers and paper  
got home about 8 o'clock 10<sup>th</sup> fine night  
Randolph went home with the sleigh  
I went the horses 10<sup>th</sup> Went to Mr Sparks funeral  
got a hole up with Hamilton got 2 pairs of  
Boots Mr Spence intended at Summers  
Snowing & Wind 11<sup>th</sup> cutting Bush Barkings  
Chairs coros Browning in the bush  
on trees I am cutting for them.
