 was true about his sister & he cryed & had could hardly  
 tell me. I'm fellow I do feel as sorry for him. He took his  
 mother up to some train to go to Enclph & George him going  
 E. M. went over after dinner to 17. to see if we could do anything  
 so I sat & pickney in orchard & George to come up rather  
 startled me at first & he asked me if I would do him  
 a favor & I said yes & he handed me a parcel with two  
 letters to read & then he treated me & cryed. Ask me out to  
 think strange of him as in me. I & I done them & I do  
 I took them over after tea. We had cups all to drink as  
 E. M. & Tommy M. W. all went to shut in P.M. went ammi & I  
 on my way over to M. W. eat & talked a long time boys got  
 later saying their sister died with inflammation on lungs  
 & Emma says but on a case of pleurisy for some & talked with  
 him. Then Emma then I've done no pickney & weaked home  
 with us. I do feel as sorry for him & his mother. Got at 11. P.M.  
 Thurs 9<sup>th</sup> Aug 1858. I not well but pickney a little. I do washing Mr  
 Haysom Pitts buried to day E. M. & M. M. went to church Sunday  
 in night (M. Kennedy) also to be buried at Enclph. Sat & G. went  
 out. Monday to Glasgow on Wed 11<sup>th</sup>

Sat 10<sup>th</sup> Aug M. W. & I finished washing. Dinning when  
 Ada Bray & Lois Jones came to spend evening. Sat I  
 went part of way home with them. I had on E. M.'s  
 coat & hat & I do sales. We lay about talking all the way  
 to M. W. See Kennedy camp along just as we were standing  
 he telling us about his sister's death. See or Dave once  
 saw her cause she discovered. Dave came back. This eve  
 Sat 11<sup>th</sup> evening I went to P.O. I waiked down behind  
 me I waited for while & Dave came up with me & we went  
 in parlour & played & sang & Pa called out "halloo"  
 to stop playing & come & make my bed paper & been  
 made for two days. Dave had a great laugh at that.  
 I gave Dave the music book & he started to go at 10

I went to do with him & we got talking about his sister  
 he told me what she thought of me. He asked me once  
 more if they was any chance for him to go with me  
 I did him kindly that I was his friend's could not be  
 any more to him. He felt very bad & I felt sorry for him  
 I waiked until clock struck twelve. Then he went.

Sun 12<sup>th</sup> Had archie & Mr Stewart for tea. I very tired & sleep  
 Mon 13<sup>th</sup> Pickney terms for our own use. John & Martha called  
 Had ada Johnson for dinner. E. M. dinn Ida & I dinn. B. Baker called  
 to meet ammi put on horse in West Spurs. Then went up to bank  
 & heard political speeches & content to ammi from his abt 1/2  
 we were with Miss Davan & brother had a nice time & calls on  
 the days for tea. We left ammi there & Ida & I came home. My calls  
 Tues 14<sup>th</sup> M. W. drove down for ammi. Then Ida & I went down on evening  
 to wash  
 Wed 15<sup>th</sup> Ada & John here for last time. A J I went up to Mr Shaw's  
 to get a real nice hand playing cards
