Hall Hot Sun 21st Snowing 22nd St. Ann's
Birth Day Fine Fernandez went to sell Fish
23rd Fernandez to Lancaster Bought Fish 24th Fine
Uncle Bill here got the Fat cow and 2 Year old
Bull for the Mill Stanley went with them
some Lambs too Early Lady Day 25th Fine
