I topped turnips and we digged out 6 rows a.m. P.M. David Milne up helped us we got in 3 waggon loads and 4 turnip loads 14 rows turnips. Mather walked down P.M. Miss Blafstone the teacher here P.M. collecting for Patriotic society of 1st Nov. we gave \$2.00.
