Had a small thunder storm about 2 o'clock this morning & quite a pour down. & rained or sprinkled off & on untill they went to church Marjorie & Marquand. went. Marjorie went to Riekmager to dinner & I got the eastest chair in the house. no threatening of a storm could start her Arthur went to the back church we had some thunder this afternoon I made our fire it was so hot had custard & bread & butter for supper. Will had 3 kills today & Beebe one yesterday she was sick for a whole week got better right away after her worm kill came but it died Mon 10 raining when we got up & continued most all day & at night poured all night. such a dreary looking night. Paul went to Clepton to draw his pay & did not come back I was sewing some & Marjorie cut out her shirt waist. she got over the river with 11 Mrs Riekmager came over after supper. Sat 11. Paul came home after dinner today was pay day he got his new hat & shoes, did not get much done washed the dishes & I cleaned up on the forenoon Marjorie work & put the paper on the shelves. Marjorie took up the old carpet on the back kitchen. it was a dirty job. Paul gone with Arthur to Eden Will with lots

Sun 13. Will & Marjorie went to Chippawa took 5 dog eggs 13 came in 94 of Gleaser 25 & paid 14 on it. Jeffer 5. Tea 15 coal out 9 wall paper for the dining room 60 & cash 20 out of Paul money. Paul & Arthur took the house out last night. while they were at Chippawa washed dishes untill 11 then churned. Paul & Marjorie went to the front room when he got back from Gonder where he & Arthur took hay. they took everything out carpet up & pounded swept paper down carpet. down just at dark & thunder storm lasted untill 11 o'clock. Friday 14. raining & pouring at times Peter De Witt came after the calves. paid 30 for the two calves. 92 & for 8 ells more they had an awful time with Will one calf it was wild. Marjorie washed had Pauls junk shirt & a collar. Will she washed her white quilt & oranges & two bath cloths. I prepared the east side of the kitchen & got the meals the children & I then cleaned up the school house instead of last Friday pouring rain when they came home for dinner. Sat 15 Paul went to Halls View to see Gonder. took 1 dog 3 eggs for bread sold them to old Leach for 25 got 5 loaves & 5 on wed. besides our own bread. Marjorie woned Paul & I on wed. besides our own bread. I cleaned the furniture shirts & collar & the two table cloths & cleaned the kitchen I washed the dining room wood work. I washed the kitchen doors & window cleaned the floor & made two pies grape & jelly pie cakes. Gonder cleaned the calf pen & Lucy went in for the first. a thunder storm came up before & lasted untill 10 a continual roll of thunder. Arthur & I sank Riekmager over to gather up railroad ties stayed at Freds untill after the storm. Sun 16 wind west & cool. sunshiny. the wind got high
