George Sims comes up to house at noon & tells me C Hughes is drunk, I go down with Geop & dismiss Hughes. Put S Huddle on to watch tonight, Hughes very bad.

1876

Go to Tanning at 6³⁰ AM. Hughes still drinking. Saw Huddle watches at Tanning last night. Inquire Mother's dwelling house & furniture for \$2500 for 3 years in Manufacturers & Merchants Mutual Co. Alpheus Brower, Hamilton Also \$2000 on Machinery &c in Tanning I pay him \$13⁵⁰ on Policy on House, C Parsons comes over in boat & returns again. He hands me \$30 for Expenses, says he'll let me have the money I ask'd for on 15th, reciev letter from S. Hueby, accepting mine written yesterday, to him Hughes joins the Sons tonight S Huddle watches tonight
