Tue Jan 13th cloudy and cold. Dick took me up to Florence this afternoon. I sent Victoria a draft for \$200

Wed Jan 14th cloudy and cool. I was writing a letter to Victoria

Thu Jan 15th cloudy a dull moderate day

Fri Jan 16th clear fore part of the day latter part cloudy and soft. I rode out with the Rose and Bossie to Thamesville the road is getting bare in places

Sun Jan 18th clear and cold. Ashton Preacht the Anniversary Sermon to day

Mon Jan 19th clear and cold two deg below zero this morning. I attended the institute meeting this afternoon there was a good attendance at the Meeting

Tue Jan 20th clear a pleasant winter day. I went over to Johns for butter

Wed Jan 21st cloudy and soft a little snow last night. I was over to Sarah's in the fore noon. Mary Paul was here this afternoon

Thu Jan 22nd clear and pleasant. Dick took me to Florence this fore noon

Fri Jan 23rd cloudy part of the day and cold. a little more snow last night

Sat Jan 24th a cold raw wind from the East was setting in the house most of the day

Sun Jan 25th fore noon cloudy; after noon clear and pleasant. Billon was here awhile
