last night. I attended a case for selling liquor  
on Sunday between Caroline Bradley & Michel  
O'Connor Inn Keeper Escott at the Station

19 Ad went to the funeral of a Daughter of Wm  
Webster she was buried at the Union Church  
I went to James Corbett to see Mr Ferguson about a  
letter I got from <sup>Rev</sup> Mr Coltart about the communion

20 Red Mr Ferguson preached this morning & Mr Cunningham  
at night

21 Ad went to Gananaque with Bessie to school I went  
collecting for Mr Ferguson full day

22 I went on the morning Express to Toronto to the Fair got  
there about 1 o'clock met David Johnston stayed  
there till I left on Friday morning there was  
a great display of Agriculture implements  
& some fine stock it was not as good a Fair  
it was at Gordon last year

23 Adam was married to day to Miss McNeil

25 got home from Toronto this afternoon all  
well there was fine weather all the time

26 I went with Wm Corbett to James Corbett to settle  
with <sup>Rev</sup> Mr Ferguson for the time that he preached  
to us Summer paid him one hundred & fifty  
dollars & James Corbett sixty five dollars for board  
& keeping his horse

27 the Rev Mr Cunningham preached this morning & Mr Ferguson at  
night

rain day 28 Ad came home with his wife on the Express they came  
at Belleville & Toronto since Wednesday there was Mr &  
Mrs Dean Wallace & his sister James Calhoun I paid

rain last night 29 I went with John Cook to <sup>see</sup> about our fair ground  
here for the

rain 30 rain this morning & snort the day Ad drew a  
load of rails from the middle fence & a load of planks  
for the drill shed the rails is to make pins
