- 4 Wednesday. John Fraser only fed the horses today. The Lamm Social at D^r Arthur Macdonald was postponed from last night until tonight - % 2 loaves 10 - 1st to messenger. Rain in A.M.
- 5 Rain since 8. A.M. cleared up. I put out the washing made on Monday. It began to rain about 4 P.M. and stopped at 6. P.M. The social at D^r Arthur was not well attended the night was bad and so were the roads Mary Macdonald was in for a while last night - Belle left this morning by the mail carriage, she proposed to go as far as George Jamieson
- 6 Fraser worked all day. Slight drizzle all day % 4 loaves 20. 1 gall coal oil 20. Sugar 25 - Marion preparing for a few for tea. Jimmie came home in the evening
- 7 Miss Macintosh and her brothers were here last night, and Mr & Mrs Brown. Ice cream 1qt from Jubart last night 60 cts. % 2 1/2 lbs of steak from Beckstead 25. We are taking all our meat from Beckstead % 2 lbs of butter 27. - 54. Paid for the milk 35 Borrowed 79 from Jimmie.
- 8 Far came at 9. P. M yesterday

- 9 Fine day, rain in morning My off in church 10. Far left this morning for Cornwall. Murdy went with with Frasers horse I made a washing % 3 loaves. Jimmie 15 Mrs Ellis paid \$2.00 15
- 10 Dull and misty in forenoon, Rain in afternoon and, a storm at night. % 2 lbs butter. 50 Sugar 1.00
- 11 Murdy went north, Rain all day % 4 loaves 20 1 bottle 10. Sewing machine oil Rubber rings for jems 1 doz 8. fly person Paid Jimmie what I borrowed. Got the percent of the factory loss of last summer 1. % 4 loaves 20
- 12 Rain. Marion went to Lancaster, with Daisy.
- 13 Dull in morning, then rain
- 14 Fine all day. % 2 1/2 lbs steak at Sandy's 25 - butter 65. two loaves 10, cheese 23. Far came in evening. Paid 35 to Cothorne for milk 99
- 15 Fine day, a large congregation
- 16 Fine in forenoon, I washed. Rained in afternoon
- 17 % 3 loaves 15 15
- 18 Fine day. Mrs Brown was here yesterday. She was going to Ottawa. Minnie Macdonald is being married today to David Kayside - Murdy went to Cornwall I took up the potatoes that were in the garden
- 19 Fine day. I made sweet pickles. Our cow had a heifer calf last night - Murdy not back yet
- 20 Fine Murdy came last night. % 2 loaves. by Davie John 10. Butter 55 Sugar 50 1.15
- 21 3 loaves 15. paid 35 for milk 30
- 22 Fine day. but cold. not many in church Far came last evening. J.P. wife and baby hear. Marion went to Macintosh's last night
- 23 Threatening rain all day. I made the washing % butter 75. coal oil 20. Soda 5. Soda 10 1.10
- 24 Showers, all day. Murdy on the beach for 1/2 day
