- 6 began to plow in the Northwest field next the road cold no frost in the ground
- 7 hard frost last night Henry went to Delta for Wats mair no work than it snowing day fine day
- 8 Henry got home with the maise this afternoon put some shingles on the house ^{if some of the water} this
- 9 heavy rain all day took the floor out of the wood shed began to make a stercobast the Rev Mr Green came here ^{this afternoon} held meeting in the church very few there ^{still raining & very dark}
- 10 took Mr Green to Escott he preached in the schoolhouse fine roads very bad the Rev Mr DeLong preached in the morning ^{in the afternoon} & the Rev Mr Dunlap
- 11 hard frost last night put gravel & plank in the floor of the Cow stable & moved the rails back so as to give more room front of the cows
- 12 went to Escott with James Sutorior to see a dead signed by his wife in the forenoon went to the funeral of the Widow Gardner in the afternoon the Rev Mr Sutherland preached in the Ebenezer church the Rev Mr Hall from Chirie lectured ^{in the church} in
- 13 snow about 4 inches last night drove sand to bank the house & gravel to grant the stable
- 14 made a door for horn Henry chaped wood
- 15 killed the bags Th. young helped draw some wood
- 16 snow swarming this morning ^{and most of the day} cut up & silled the bags they weighed the Black one 283 lb. white one 255 lb. the Rev Mr Hather's came here of the Express ^{this afternoon} the Rev Mr Dunlap preached this morning ^{the church was full} & Mr. Hather's preached there ^{we all went} at the church at night
