February 1910

- 1. Tuesday. Fine day. Far came at 5 P.M. Got butter from factory about 4 lbs, Council met today Murdy cash for Ann Hall 20²⁵
- 2 Far and Jimmie left for Cornwall about 10 A.M. Jimmie with a team and the Sage Far in cutter Murdy by 4 loaves
- 3 Stormy day, the first storm of the winter, looks like will last some days
- 4 Turned very cold for bread
- 5 Murdy cash 25. Murdy has tooth ache 25
- 6 Cold not many in church
- 7 Mercury down to about 15 or 20. Our big Hockey team went to Alexandria to play.
- 8 Turned mild I made a small washing
- 9 Murdy left for Gose to Cousin Marys place to run some lines she is selling wood
This is a th Wednesday. Had Ann Hall 1/2 day, gave her 35²⁵ 5 for the last time. Got 4 lbs butter from Factory yesterday Murdy by rolled wheat 25
1 gallon coal oil 15
- 10 Stormy. Murdy did not go to the Gose today Murdy 4 loaves 20²⁵
- 11 Fine day. Murdy went to Gose
- 12 Began to storm about 6 A.M. Stormed all day Murdy by 3 loaves 18. The Hockey match postponed
- 13 Calmed down not many in church
- 14 Fine day roads heavy Murdy went to Gose. J. Lavolette paid 2.50. 7 1/2 lbs lard 40
1/2 lb tea 20. 4 bars Fells N Soap 25 1 lb macaroni 10. Molasses 20
2 lamps chimneys 15 4 ginger 10. 1/4 cream tart 10
Paid Jimmie 35 that I got last week for Ann Hall 35
- 15 Very fine day
- 16 Turned stormy last night. saw 4 P.M. getting cold Mrs Shaw & Mrs Gun were in for a few minutes
