1 Saturday 9 P.M. It has been raining all day
fine growing day Far came home in the rain
and has a very bad cold

2 pretty fair & fine long day

3 I washed today, dinner

4 My washing is on the grass

5 I was not at prayer meeting
Auntie came over in afternoon brought
2 pair of socks, fine day 1/2 gallon coal oil & matches 14

6 Thursday women's meeting at Big Williams
It began to rain in early morning and look
like wet all day Marion is not gaining
but her mind is stronger, but her physical
nerves are very weak

7 Wet today also, Jimmie drew 4 loads of manure

8 Raining today drew manure in fore noon. Got
4 loaves at Dunlop's 25 1/2 lb tea at Willis's 25
Far came at 6 P.M. Auntie was here in afternoon

9 Raining all day. Not many in church, Jimmie has
gone to Lancaster with Far, Marion was pretty
well today, she does not get much sleep

20 I had no time to write since the 9th
I was wetting the onions, this morning
and saw the Martintown Cross Band Pass
Comin Mary Davis wife and Sophia Carter
passed in a buggy and in about 3/4 of
an hour, they were brought back buggy
shot, all badly bruised Mary's lower lip
was cut through and the Dr put four
stitches in it Davis wife had her forehead
cut and had nine stitches put in Wesley
was the Dr who attended them

21 Lassy went to Sandy Osins. Lots of people
calling to see the sick. Marion got a pair of
boots on the 19, at Hill. 2.75 and then got 2 1/2 yds
