2 Rain again

3 Saturday Auntie came over today
Cousin Jimmie and Harry went off
for the front in Aunties boat
About noon it began to rain in the
forenoon, and cleared at times.
our boys went to Lancaster to play
against the Valley fields

4 Looks like dry weather

5 fine day. I went with Auntie to the
Front. Got home about 7. P. M. Far
was at home for Sunday. Pa paid 53 15

6 Got 9 1/2 lb chese 110. to 1 pan bread 25 1-35
fine day all farmers busy

7 Another fine day. I baked, got Cotton 25
Thread 5 L. 50. We have put in twelve 55
loads ^{hay} from the Orlage farm today

8 Sent one load of hay to Auntie put in wood at home

9. Rained a little early in morning then about
4.30. P. M. a smart shower. good deal of
rain fell

10 Pa went to Front to see the campers boy were at
the hay I had a letter from Uncle Sandy on Wednesday 56 55
