Mr James Cameron Island June 5

Friday 5th June Put the Raft on the Hoia
 & Boarded some on the north side Went to Charles
 Got some Turnip seed & Onions & the Hammer
 2 Men here Lee & Reuben Martin's son all night
 Raining Mary Birch Paid in a Boat close to
 shore 6th Went to Chustee seen Mary Ann's
 Baby about a month old chustee says it belongs
 to Thomas More got 13 pine Boards & 1 hemlock
 Board cost 2 Dollars paid 1 Dollar got rowe
 him a Dollar yet on them got the scythes 2 of them
 saw a limlet Cut the Door of the house Raining
 7th Corpus Chustee Grand proceeded in a Boat
 Sandy went home with his tools Ellen down
 Ellen made a Cap for the Boy brought a
 Hammer from Morris's Sandy did Charle
 here gave him potatoes to plant he had soap
 Found 5 Large staves & 4 small ones, 8th Raining
 Fishing perch caught 44 put them in the pen
 but 20 of them got away Sandy & Ellen sharking
 a Raft cutting poles left them 9th Oar Mary's
 Birth Day Went to Summers a treat all day
 1/3 on credit Bought of A Summers 2 Bunches
 of Shingles 12/6 10 lb nails shingles 2/6 Donald
 Summers & Robert down for the Canoe went to
 Alexis Island for Boards Richard Grear here
 10th Began to Shingle the north side 11 calling for Charle
 Sandy working at the door cleaning out the cellar 12th
 Went to Salmon River with the wool 15 lb only got 12 Bales
 7 cents a lb orled and carded paid 10 cents Duty got the Receipt
 of the wool for 4 cents Bought P. Buchanan 4 lb nails 1/4
 1 Bushel of potatoes 1/6 crackers & cheese 1/2 Got the Churn fixed
 at Mr. Giffens 1/3 not paid to day John Angus came

Working at the house Began to shingle the
 South side John Angus & Mrs Fishing
 got none went to Fish with the light Sandy
 Lost a shingle on the City of Anneton Began
 to tow here hoeing some Mosquitoes Bad
 Yicks some young Chickens 1/4 them Jack
 Bad with Book Ellen made a Kibble Chens scrobbles
 the Wheat 14th Jack Ellen & Sandy went to
 Chustee's 3 canoes went down 13th I and
 Sandy & Jack crossed gave John Angus the Berries
 to take to Ellen left the Doc. E. P. Poo on the
 Island Settled with old Basell about the
 Line all clear got the round ridge from Nicholas
 took a hook out of Senos' Bow hand
 Henry Bad with a Felon on his finger &
 Great Gale of North wind coming home
 Sandy & Ellen crossed for the Shingles &
 for the Wheel & Keel gave Sandy an Order
 to get them cedar shingles 7/6 16th came
 Back Ellen & Sandy took 2 Doves came high
 Wind working at the Potatoes 17th working
 at the House finished shingling the South side Began
 the West Gable end hoeing some 18th 4th day
 the deciding the Battle of Waderloo finished the
 West Gable end put out 2 Lines Tom went off
 John Cameron & Fray here stopt all night
 19th Went to A Summers Bought 2 lb Tea 1/10
 1 lb Tobacco 2/3 2 hal Whiskey 1/3 Soda - 1/4 1/2 Peppar 1/4
 7 lb nails 1/3 1 Bottle Portet 1/2 2 Bowls - 1/4 a Hat for
 nothing Wind very high Began the East end
 of the Gable 20th Working end of the House
 Mary Ann's Wife here Bought a Sturgeon Packet from her
 gave some Meal and Potatoes
