We brought a load of Danbury oats from J.L. over before noon. I hauled load wood for thrashing P.M. Willie drove down town got at Shortree's meat 60 cts hand 50 cts went to Bryers near Elora got basket of walnuts 55 cts plus 50 cts 7 to 8. 55 cts
