Father and Mother up in P.M. Girls went up to see Mrs Willie Bonet in P.M. with Jack (Clark) in buggy. Our heifer Judith calved in field in evening a heifer soon calf.

23

Thursday

Fine in A.M. sunny and warm rained in P.M. got cloudy and cooler. We got 3 loads oats in No 1 in A.M. Girls went up to Mrs Mc Fellows with Clark, Jack and Clark's buggy and brought down Sophia and Margaret Newton.

24

Friday

Cool sunny windy. We pulled the pease No 1 with sulky rake in A.M. In P.M. finished hauling in oats in No 1 3 loads and hauled 4 loads from No 7.

25

Saturday

Cloudy day drizzling in morning. We hauled in the pease to-day 5 loads also 3 loads oats from No 7 wheat on top of loads. Mrs. Mrs. Mc Fellon and Sophia Mc Fellon came down to-day and took up Sophia and Margaret Newton they are going west next week. I went down town at night on wheel. Paid Sophia \$1.00 for dress. Georgina got in Toronto
