Saturday 27th fine
I hauled two loads of wheat
to Goldies Mill. 60^{bu} 45^{lb}
x 59^{bu} 65^{lb} at 93¢ per bu
got moths teeth fixed \$1⁵⁰
laces 10¢ per unit. 15, planks 14

Sunday 28th fair & soft
Father Children & I went
to church in morning and
Children & I to S. S. Col
for Father. 30. and myself 30
D. S. 21.

Monday 29th Stormy D.W.
Father & C. Chores and filled
up wheat I took two loads
to mill.

Tuesday 30th fine fair
We had the worst block
for years on the railway
today. Few engines and
a way car passed through
going west about 6 P.M. the
first since yesterday at
that time. I went to town
went to bank and deposited \$202⁵²
that I got for fall wheat at 93⁸⁹⁵
¢ per bu, got news for shoes
at W^c Larens. then arranged
to get our slings & car
