Sun 22 sun came out bright but cold west wind  
darkened up all at once on the south west & thunder  
quite loud when Harpore was going to church  
I had a dull headache. the minister preached  
a good sermon quite a few out. toward  
night the wind raised & blew hard I rained some  
Mon 23 sun shining but cold got dull. the teacher  
did not come Mrs Walmley went down after  
her. I churned & worked the butter & put the  
pears on in pretzels had to core them over they  
stood fine sat. Hattie came over from Buffalo  
we started the fire in the room for the first  
Arthur ploughing opposite the school house &  
started sat afternoon Paul took his saw down  
to Chippawa to get his saw sharpened paid  
Thu 24. Well walked to Chippawa the pair 20  
on the huffers. Hattie over in the afternoon when

the teacher came. I washed quite a washing  
& made a sponge cake for supper. besides  
boiling feed for the pigs  
Wed 25 bitter cold wind east. Well sold  
the turkey to Ernest Bossie over came in  
9.82. for 8 turkeys. I finished the washing  
& made 3 pumpkin pies. Harpore baked bread  
Arthur ploughing. only two scholars today  
Thurs 26 Thanksgiving. the teacher here all  
day. Paul churning at Persons. I dressed  
two chickens we had them for dinner &  
supper had them fried. Cassie Tuft went  
to Buffalo yesterday. John Marks to the  
the house. Hattie & Arthur over on the  
evening. on a sun shine in the forenoon & part  
of the afternoon then darkened like rain  
Friday 27 looked like rain 3 scholars  
the teacher took her dinner Harpore took her to  
Chippawa had 5 lbs 10¢ & 24. 1.20. got a gal of 19  
the bus cost 10.25 of granulated sugar 1/2 lb tea 13 nails 5  
also ch food 25. 31 on the book. I churned & peeled  
some pears. Well killed his pig & took it to Chippawa  
Sat 28. cold west wind I peeled some more pears  
& swept & dusted the school house. Son & I immediately  
brought our mail Paul went at night after it  
Harpore came in forenoon after dinner cleaned  
the kitchen. getting awfully cold. going to freeze  
something awful. how the duck tick
