This is Randolph's birthday and a fine day
 it is Auntie Annie come with her doggy
 she will stay all winter. Jimmie left for
 Queens today. Got 1 lb tobacco 10cts just
 Far was home on Sunday Pa gave him
 \$20⁰⁰ to buy wire for fence
 Saturday was wet all day. Jimmie went
 to St. Gerome Rev Tom. Smith of Kingston
 gave his lecture on "The boys I knew." on
 Friday 26th. We were all there. Jimmie gave
 me \$15⁰⁰ I gave \$5⁰⁰ to him we heard
 that Alick Brown Toronto. had his
 eye blinded on Thursday

28 Another fine day got 1 pm bread 25
 I sent a letter to Far yesterday
 and three papers. Jimmie and
 Joe his cat today Murchy and
 it by mail cost 8cts
 29 Fine day butchered a halfer 2 years
 in the summer. gave Far. Gave 1 hind
 quarter. He was over with our flour
 which had been at the Gene Station
 for a week, 4 bags. We got 2 furs (over
 50cts. 1 gull coal oil 25
 30 St Andrews day. Morning dull about
 11 A.M. began to drizzle. and then
 began night all day. I did not go to
 church I felt unwell
