wheat, 98<sup>c</sup>. Chopking. 45<sup>c</sup> 400  
bgt oat meal \$1<sup>00</sup>, pinches 98  
100

Sunday. 7<sup>th</sup> fine  
Luz Jean & I went to Church  
in morning heard W.C.  
Preach a Consecration sermon  
it was very good. we all  
stayed at home the rest  
of the day.

Monday. 8<sup>th</sup> fine  
we did chores and worked  
at wood. Mr Broadfoot  
Came for his Bull. Price  
of nichol, recd bal of Price 75<sup>00</sup>

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> fine  
C & I chored & cut wood  
in morning and. I went  
to Andrew Derbys funeral in  
afternoon, it was a very  
large funeral, went to town  
put \$40<sup>00</sup> in bank. Paid for 1/2 ton  
Bran. @ 14 = 7<sup>00</sup> to be delivered with  
fords, pd for molasses & prunes 1<sup>00</sup> 700

for one Hundred and twenty five
