M N's for dinner. I had Corn A.M. went
to Uncle Sam's raising P.M. W. fine Clear
5 Finished drawing clay A.M. Put in posts
on townline. I had Corn & Potatoes
I took sell to Morrison this evening. W. warm
6 I began crossplowing fallow I went to Merkle's
A.M. moved that in fence corners P.M. W. Clear
7 I plowed I & J B nailed boards on posts
east of lane on townline W. fine
Sunday 8 I & Nang & Children went to meeting
at Cedar Grove John & girls kept house remarks
by B. C. Sermon on ^{by R. D. Hoover}
9 I & Nang went to Chris. Stevens P.M. Matty
Cook is Mendick she cannot go home yet
10 I plowed I chored A.M. went to Merkle's
11 I began to cut grass in meadow ^{P.M. W. very warm slight shower}
Old Machine gave out after cutting a few
acres went to J Ramer's bought a new 2
wheel Kirby mower on shares with B. C.
for \$60.00 & old machine. W. fine
11 B. C. Jo. Meuns Cut for me W. fine Cool
12 Meuns began cutting this morning Machine
wouldn't cut any more drew in 12 loads P.M.
B. C. & Meuns & Mainland helped W. warm
13 Drew in 6 loads G & John took one load to J B's
I mowed some with new mower this evening it
works very well W. fine pretty warm
14 I plowed for B. C. I finished by meadow
A.M. then we raked & cocked till supper
a slight rain stopped us Mainland helped P.M.
Sunday 15 All went to meeting at Hebron remarks
by R. D. Hoover Sermon on ^{by B. C.}

Old M. Night ^{July} at this well 37 here P.M. we took a ride
to A B's after supper W. very warm
16 drew in 12 loads hay the last in big meadow
except raking B. C. two men helped P.M.
17 I began mowing behind Cedar house about 9 A.M.
nearly finished G removed fallow A.M. moved
fence corners in meadow & plowed Potatoes
W. soaking rain last night warm today
18 Finished mowing 2 hours then began to rake & draw
drew 6 loads till supper then raked & cocked
the rest of field after supper. W. warm
19 I & boys went to Cedar Grove A.M. had turnip
20 I brought home new Kirby ^{or from show} & mowed
cut some barley near B. C. A.M. cut small round
wheat below house P.M. & had turnips W. Clear
21 Finished drawing in hay except raking & loads
Mainland helped B. C. A.M. I went to Clarks
raising for me P.M. W. fine Clear
Sunday 22 all went to meeting at Wierman's
remarks by B. C. Sermon on ^{by R. D.}
J. B. B. went to Finleys & I ^{at home} P.M.
23 Cut wheat below garden with new reaper
work very well. W. very warm Clear
24 Cut most of wheat in west end of big field W. very warm
25 finished wheat, very good crop. Cut ^{part} of barley in
east end of big field G & Mainland cut near B. C.'s
with Cradle & Ocy the W. very very sultry & warm
26 Finished cutting barley G & Mainland bound I
& Nang went to Merkle's & to J. H. Ramer's
very sick W. few drops of rain P.M. very close
27 had lunch I & B. C. took a drive with Colt
after supper. W. Close. heavy rain P.M. some light
28 had turnip A.M. G & Mainland bound barley P.M. I & boys
drew in 3 loads hay raking P.M. W. very warm
Sunday 29 I & Nang & little boys started to meeting
at Attona heavy shower near Belford got wet
then went to Massacuse Falls W. very warm
30 drew in barley near B. C. & some out of big field
^{W. very warm}
