W. fire & Cleo a sheep in
Dec 1 A & Henry helped Fleming fix a Box
Stall for his young Colt J fixed approach
at Bridge on 11th Leon & at Bridge near
Fleming. A.M. he & A made a stone
walk from Pump to gate at Barnyard
W. fair mild. Hermon's came to stay
all night

Sunday 2 all went to Meeting at the barn
except J he staid with Susanna
by C. Burkholder Hermon's at J.D. P.
first part of the C. by Br C. Lida. Harv
& David Harv's daughter Tilly were here to
dinner. Bayly & Aunt Lora Burkholder
were here. P.M. W. mild cloudy A.M. fine
& more clear P.M.

Dec 1918
3 Boys Chores & brought home some
limb wood A.M. A helped Fleming
draw straw stack into barn Henry
helped Br D's fix Tumbling dam &
J Chores & plowed back garden. P.M.
J & Mary went to Cedar Grove & called
at J.D. P. Burkholder's to see Baby boy
Mary was there from Wednesday morning
until yesterday evening. W. very fine summer
like Indian
4 Killed our 5 Hogs the whole family helped
got done soon after 3 P.M. W. Cloudy
misty mild A.M. slow steady rain
P.M. raining yet we got the hogs all cut
up before dinner & had the work
all inside. P.M.

5 Henry & Adeline helped David kill hogs
I went to J.D. P. Burkholder's & came by Br D's
& brought C. hop home A.C. J. Burkholder
drew along where fence was south
of bush. A.M. J & A plowed all
orchard P.M. W. very fine getting
colder towards evening I salted Pork
6 A & Henry drove stones off fence strip
south of bush & began plowing it I took
up some tiles in field north of old
orchard & put them in again (they were
stopped) he took Butter & Eggs to
