- Mon May 18. Fine and cold. ice. I came home. Cut grass at Annie's
- Tue May 19. Fine and warmer. Put in Screen door. Dahlias. at Dr. called at Miss Edeys in the evening.
- Wed May 20. Fine much warmer. Nelson Smellie trimming trees evergreens. I painted South Verandah and Steps. ^{Dr. here}
- Thur May 21. Fine warmer. no need of fire. called to see Mr. Watson
- Fri May 22. Fine moderately warm. Annie has cold in bed here. a light shower but very little.
- Sat May 23. Fine but very cold after thunder this a.m. down to freezing at night. fire on. I called at Mrs Smellie in to hear Radio and Races in afternoon.
- Sun May 24. Very cold. N. W. wind ice coldest 24th for years. at morning Church. Frank Scasdale had A. and I for tea. Three girls murdered. Mrs Mick Watson at farm.
- Mon May 25. Fine and still cold N. wind. Annie teaching and at Leggies. I walked to Wellie's for a while and invited to Mr Davidson's for tea at Gravel yard and in to see fire works later. Annie and I.
