- Thur Dec 19. Fine day, mild. I walked out to enquire for Willie's, went to Presbyterian Xmas tree in the evening.
- Fri Dec 20. Fine day and mild, but not thawing to make it muddy.
- Sat Dec 21. Fine very mild and thawing making it muddy, I went out to Willie's,
- Sun Dec 22. Rained heavily through night, mild dull & foggy. Annie Aunt Nellie and I at Memorial Service for Mr Lawrence in the afternoon. Aunt Mattie and I in at Mr Davidson's in the evening.
- Mon Dec 23. Fine and mild we washed, it turned colder in evening.
- Tue Dec 24. Much colder, east wind, we went to Aunt Lizzie's for dinner. Started to storm at noon but very dry snow.
- Wed Dec 25. "Christmas day" we spent at Mother's just the boys out, others sick. no skating, quite a lot of snow but not much good for sleighing.
