Wednesday May 10<sup>th</sup> 1899

I went to town in morning  
 bgt Harness. 50<sup>c</sup>, hardware <sup>at post office</sup> 85<sup>c</sup> 50 85  
 paid ac at Posters & Coghlan's 2<sup>25</sup> 225  
 bgt meat, 95<sup>c</sup> got my teeth fixed  
 two filled <sup>\$1<sup>50</sup></sup>, ~~to~~ got shoes  
 mended, 20<sup>c</sup> 20  
 Shows last night

Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> dull

I got things ready for Father  
 to start pointing new house  
 Geo hauled two loads of sand  
 and then hauled manure on  
 potato ground. I planted  
 garden in afternoon  
 O.A.C. had their young  
 x cow here today

Friday 12<sup>th</sup> fine

We hauled bal of manure  
 to potato ground and  
 started to plow it in  
 then I went to town with  
 just of Chop. 14 bags. 70 70  
 bgt Corn. 93<sup>c</sup> got wagon 93  
 fixed 25<sup>c</sup> glass 10<sup>c</sup> 25  
 10  
 bgt dry goods \$1<sup>63</sup>. 163

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> Cook & dairy

We finished plowing in potato  
 manure in morning and  
 hauled manure from  
 Shales in afternoon four  
 loads @ 15<sup>c</sup> per load. Father  
 x took Queen down to Sortys  
 in afternoon put her to Lord  
 Channing.

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> fine

Mary Willie Jennie & I  
 went to Church in morning  
 heard Rev Crew of Epworth  
 League, preach on, Character  
 & Training up the young  
 Ineg. W & I went to S.S.

Monday 15<sup>th</sup> fine

Geo & I hauled manure  
 from Shales. 9 loads  
 also got run home
