Geordy fixed the old baber-lough I have done nothing for a week back with a bad cold

I went to Mr Dalings for to take his oath to an account against the Malkomsons for wood Ellen went to young with Geordy to see them before she goes home they went in the Buggy fine day

cold day with high wind Geordy split some wood

I did nothing it is so cold & blustering with a little snow the Red Mr. Brown preached this morning Mr. Nicholson ^{at night}

Ad went to Whites & got his horses Chad Ellen went to Brackville on the Express on her way home we get a Telegram that Mr. Mr. Elhenic is dead & to be buried tomorrow at 2 o'clock Tam not able to go

Ad & Geordy went to the Shanty to day Ad brought home a lag for a water trough at home there is no sloughing the wind blew the snow off the roads

Ad went to the Shanty this morning he intends to stop there & along the cattle fine day

fine day attend the cattle home a bad cold

Ad & Geordy came home this afternoon Ad has drawing wood to home they all went an oyster supper & concert at Weston's Hall supper at Stewarts house 16 they did not go to the Shanty to day very full warm day
