taken of stones Ploughing above the Le
Gordon came took his Tool chest
him a Sadder and Benches got 3 Ducks
Fine picking stones of the Wheat Leander crossed
to East night 1st Sea Fernandez came from Cape
ploughed in Meadow above the corn Turned cool Rain
hiring up stairs took Barley and oats to the long
oats to Charlie Craig ploughing upper field then
to Dundee there is something wrong with the engine
re Back of the Barn Fernandez to Cornwall

solved 12 Bushels of oats Harrowing
Putting Manure on the Potato ground
Fernandez to Lancaster setting fires
on the south side above the Bay the

North Wind getting Rats named hard
to night 9th Rain Barnhart for oats
got 15 Bushels So Dougiet to pay
for him One of Lewis Boys for
Potatoes Butter and Milk Rain
quite cool Leander crossed chickens
out taking the Power apart 10th
Fine freezing at night cutting stove
Wood Eddy Kenshaw for oats 4 Bushels
took down my Mail Frost to night
and ice 11th This is the Day of the
Big Fight Corbet and Jeffries Capt
a Free Run Well Ploughing Potato
ground Stanley splitting stove wood
Killed the calf for Carlo took a
Bag of Potatoes to a Fraser Fernandez
took part of the Harrow to Blacksmith
taken ashes out of the Leech
Gibberies Beat Corbet
