After breakfast Dick, Daddy and I moved all the horses over into the big barn and then began to clean off the floor of the same building and found it very poor. I churned this morning and Sarah who felt poorly baked. We cleaned up a little around the horse stable and after dinner Daddy, Dick and I drove down town in the rack and I got a pair of heavy boots and did some other shopping for the house.
