Fine hazy sunny day very warm. We finished cutting No 7 W. to-day and stoked most of it up. Father in for dinner he had been up at I believe fifty told us some cattle were out. After dinner Wilki drove him down Kate in buggy then looked for cattle and put them back again. We dropped some pig in evening. Mary walked up this morning she had been down home last night she gave Mrs Vanalpine 5 lbs butter for sheep having eaten her cabbage. \$1.00
